Consideration is given to timely, diverse and factual topics of interest to the majority of attendees or individual segments like wireless, cable or telco. You are welcome to submit more than one proposal for consideration. New topics for smaller niche audiences i.e., planners, engineers, trouble-shooters, QC etc. are needed as well. There will be two large seminar rooms and one smaller room for more niche topics.

Seminars are provided both days. Each speaker is allotted 45-minutes for their presentation followed by a 5-minute Q&A period. Additional questioning from clients can be directed to your host exhibitor table for further discussion. All applications are presented to an industry advisory board for review and rated by their popularity and content. Seminar speakers are to provide a presentation that is not brand or company oriented. The representing exhibitor or sponsoring company can be mentioned in the introduction. Speakers need to have excellent presentation skills, good product knowledge and be well spoken and clearly understood in the English language.

Three seminar rooms provided throughout the two day show are equipped with a podium and microphone, a wireless mic and an 8 ft screen and projector. After the seminar, you are asked to provide a digital version of the presentation to CommTech Show staff or to info@commtechshow.com, for placement on the CommTech Show website. Access is provided to Attendees only.

We are looking for suggestions for a 2-hour, hands-on workshop or think tank panel on Day 2 in PM. The 2009 show had a well-attended splicing workshop where attendees rotated to various stations for hands-on demonstrations.
